Rescue Calls

Public Safety responded to five (5) medical calls this past week. Three (3) people were transported to area hospitals.

Disturbance

Public Safety took a report of ATVs driving in an empty lot located in the 500 blk. of Bounty, at about 2:00 am. The Public Safety Officer met with the residents, owners of the ATV, who apparently did not realize this was a problem. Further investigation revealed several other infractions. Written warnings are being sent to the residence.

Found Property

Public Safety took a report of a cell phone found in a back yard. Officers were able to identify the owner and return the phone.

BCSO Assists

CWL Public Safety assisted the BCSO for a domestic related incident in the 100 blk. of Briar Cliff.
