Rescue Calls

Public Safety responded to four (4) medical calls this past week. Three (3) people were transported to area hospitals.

Vandalism

Public Safety took a report of a vehicle being egged, while parked in a driveway located in the 100 blk. of Staffordshire Dr. Although the car had already been washed, the Officer located evidence in the immediate area. There are no suspects at this time.

An Officer took a report of vandalism to a stop sign located at the intersection of Briarcliff and CWD. Advertisements had been placed on the sign.

Neighbor Dispute

Public Safety responded to the 500 block of Bounty for an ongoing neighbor dispute. One (1) neighbor was not clear about many of our CWL rules. The other neighbor was upset about rules being broken. The Officer did his best to mediate the issues and offer advice to both residents.

Public Safety Officers responded to the 100 blk. of Columbia St. for another neighbor dispute. Peace was able to be restored.

BCSO Assists

CWL Public Safety assisted the BCSO for a domestic related incident in the 200 blk. of Piccadilly Drive.

Suspicious Subjects

Public Safety was summoned to the East Gate after 1:00 am, to deal with a subject who was trying to gain entry into CWL by stating he was a private investigator. Further investigation revealed he was not an investigator, but a "repo" man attempting to locate a vehicle. BCSO had arrived at the scene and re-enforced our not letting this subject into CWL. The repo person was advised to return when he had acquired the proper documentation.

Noise Ordinance Complaints

Public Safety Officers responded to four (4) noise complaints. All residents complied, two (2) written warnings were issued.

Loose Dog Call

Public Safety responded to three (3) loose dog calls this week. One (1) call was unfounded. One (1) citation and one (1) written warning were issued.

Lake Patrol

The Lake Patrol experienced a relatively slow week. Several fishermen were checked for license and catch. There were no issues to be reported.
