Unfinished Business

- **Programs** – Mindy Brown has been hired for fitness orientation and potential programs (couch to 5k).
Deep water Tabata was discussed, potential times and days TBA. Aqua Zumba was also discussed, potential times and possible conflict with deep water Tabata.
- **Bunco** – was March 16th, we had 19 players – next Bunco is April 20
- **Lake & Links Fest**- Recreation Commission will be hosting a “Sorta 5K” (the route is just shy of a 5K) as their contribution to Lake and Links. There will be four age categories: men, women, 13-17 and 12 and under. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
- **Dog Park** – Planting more trees was discussed along with the potential for a small shelter being built.
Implementing a lock system on the gate was discussed. It would be like that of the boat dock rental, keys would be purchased, and residents would provide a \$10 deposit for a key to access the park.
- **Rockford Rivet’s game** – CWL attending a game is still being investigated
- **Playground equipment and swing sets** – various vendors are being looked at, the commission is in favor of a community build (volunteers would help with the build)
