- Joe Rush reported that water clarity is improving but lake levels are still down 12 inches. He observed surface algae at Fisherman's Cove and small areas of milfoil.
- The rain garden looks like it is working well after rainfall.
- We are still waiting on the final plan approval from the EPA.
- Joe Rush shared results from spring electrofishing and said the bass and bluegill were good in relative weight. Bluegill were 15% over 8 inches, Walleye were low, and Perch weights are good.
- The Bass Tournament had 10 teams participating. First place came in at 21.9 which was down a little from last year at 24.
- The fish order will not be until spring
- Joe Rush met with Paul from the DNR to discuss the basins and permitting for the dredging project. Paul will let Joe know if any permitting is needed.
- The budget wish list will include additional docks.
- Several residents requested consideration of a plan to target shorelines for weed control.
- The Dam inspection was completed on 10-12-2021 and the preliminary results were good.
- The fall fish shocking will take place within the next couple of weeks.
