Did you know that the Burpee Museum of Natural History maintains more than 100,000 items in its permanent collection? History comes alive here, from the smallest bugs to massive mammals and dinosaurs.

Burpee offers an interactive approach to learn about the world around us and how it all began, through exhibits, classes, special events, tours, summer camp, trips and more.



The lower level of the museum contains their biology and paleontology laboratories where you can watch through a viewing window as specimens are conserved and prepared for museum collections and exhibits. The viewing windows are open so you can ask questions.

Scientists from around the world have gathered in these same laboratories to view and discuss items in this immense collection and of course to view Jane- the world's most complete Juvenile T Rex which is on exhibit on the floors above.

For me one of the most exciting things I learned is that the museum has volunteer programs for all age groups which allow you hands on experience as you delve deeper into natural history. This includes expeditions where you learn how to prospect for, and how to properly excavate bones and fossils at two active search sites where Burpee is currently working in Eklalaka Montana and Hanksville, Utah

If you ever wanted to dig up dinosaur bones- here's your chance! While any specimens found will go back to the Burpee Museum collection, you will be credited with the discovery and the honor of naming the find.

Jane, as well as Burpee's sub-adult Triceratops Homer, were both discovered and excavated by Burpee volunteers who participated in the program. By the way, Homer was found by a young boy who named his find Homer after Homer Simpson. I'm just saying...wouldn't that be fun!

REVENUE REPORT:

The number of golfers at Savannah Oaks is breaking records in 2023. So far we have had 4,722 golfers which is 1,869 more golfers than in 2022. Total revenues are \$41,720 which is an increase of \$14,269 from 2022.







From the Table - Just a Bite By S.L. Bartels, Drew Ct.

Back to Back Bacon Bits!

I microwaved the last par-baked slice of bacon we had in our refrigerator this morning, so I am ready and raring to go with more about this beloved protein.

What a difference a few decades makes! In the 90s it was low-fat everything - BUT-

Fat Is Back! The Keto diet certainly helped usher it back in. Bacon, as well as other fats, are on everyone's favorite ingredient list these days; in part because there's a lot of flavor in fat. There's also that enticing smell and that satisfying crunch one gets from a crisp slice of bacon. Mmm, mmm, good.



Crisp bits of bacon can be mixed in with roasted vegetables, used as a garnish on soups or added to chocolate chip cookies. Bacon fat can be used to fry eggs, pop popcorn, make gravy, season a cast iron pan or make any of your favorite snacks or meals

However, rendering fat from other meat scraps for more flavorful cooking has been used in restaurants for years. The bits of fat and/or skin that are trimmed from roasts, stew meat, and fowl, can be rendered and used as a savory alternative to butter or oil for roasting potatoes, sautéing greens, frying eggs and toasting rice for pilaf. Fat rendered from beef trimmings can be brushed onto steaks as they cook or used in place of oil in your marinades.

How to portion and save rendered fats for future use:

- 1. Pour rendered fat into a bowl and refrigerate. Once it is solid, the fat can be scooped into teaspoon (or larger) portions and placed on a lined sheet pan and frozen.
- The frozen portions can be stored in the freezer (in a zip-lock bag) and used as a substitute for butter or oil when a meaty flavor is desired.

Now, for some recipes:

BLLT Sandwich

The Maine Lobster Fest begins in August so let's celebrate with a Bacon, Lobster meat, Lettuce and Tomato Sandwich on white bread or roll. Quantities of proteins, choice of condiments are yours. And yes, you can use "fake" lobster meat if you like.



Potato-Bacon Soup Shooters Ingredients:

4 slices of bacon 1 peeled and chopped russet potato 2 cups chicken broth

Bacon drippings

2 tablespoons butter 1 cup heavy cream

1 cleaned, chopped leek (white part only)

Instructions:

- 1. Cook the bacon slices in a skillet until crisp. Remove bacon from the pan and set aside. Leave the bacon drippings in the pan. (The soup gets extra bacon flavor from the drippings)
- Melt the butter with the drippings over medium heat. Add the chopped leek and potato. Cook until leek is
- Add the chicken broth and heavy cream. Simmer until the potatoes are tender, about 15 minutes; then puree in a blender in batches until smooth. Serve in small glasses, with chopped bacon sprinkled on top.

Candied Bacon Bits

Makes about 1/4 cup

Ingredients:

4 slices of bacon cut into 1/2-inch pieces

softened, about 5 minutes.

- 2 teaspoons dark brown sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon cider vinegar

Instructions:

- Cook bacon in a skillet over medium heat until crisp and well rendered, 6-8 minutes.
- Using a slotted spoon, remove bacon from skillet and set aside. Remove bacon fat from skillet for another purpose and return bacon pieces to the skillet.
- Add brown sugar and vinegar; Cook over low heat, stirring constantly until bacon is evenly coated.
- Transfer to plate in a single layer and allow to cool completely. Enjoy!


