Watercraft Registration & Renewals Email documents to cwl@candlewicklake.org
Boats & Personal Watercraft (Jet-skis/Waverunners)

Mail, email, or drop off your current registration, proof of \$100,000.00 liability insurance,

and the completed watercraft registration form and a new decal will be issued.

Maximum boat length is 20' and there is a 90 HP limit on all motors operating on the lake.

There is no charge for the decal. All watercraft not registered to your Candlewick Lake address in 2023 must be inspected by Public Safety before it goes on the lake. All motorized watercrafts are required to be registered, have a new decal displayed every year, and have the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL displayed on both sides of the watercraft.

Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office.

Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.

Dog Park Registration

Guest Fishing Passes Email pass request form to cwl@candlewicklake.org

Anyone age 16 and over is required to always have an Illinois Fishing License and a Candlewick Guest Fishing Permit in their immediate possession while fishing at Candlewick Lake. Active-duty military personnel and disabled veterans need to present a Military ID in lieu of an Illinois Fishing License and Candlewick Guest Fishing Pass.

Annual Pass (Valid May 1st – April 30th) \$30.00 each - Limit 4 per household

Daily Pass \$10.00 each - Limit 5 per day

Three Day Pass (Consecutive Days) \$15.00 – Limit 5 per day

Guest Pool Passes Residents must be with their guests while at the Candlewick Lake Pool.

Children age 9 and younger must be accompanied by a chaperone that is at least 16 years old.

Annual Pass (Valid May 25th – September 2nd or when pool closes for season.) \$35.00 each - Limit 4 per household

Daily Pass \$5.00 each Your Member ID serves as your Resident Pool Pass.

2024/2025 Member ID Card Information

It is not necessary to renew your Member ID card if your Member ID card has your bar code printed on it. The following amenities will be included with your dues and will require a Member ID card. Your Member ID card must be presented at the time of service.

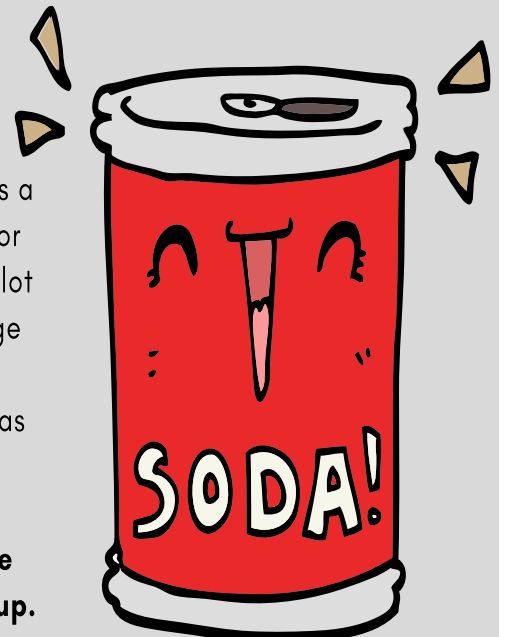


CAN COLLECTION BINS

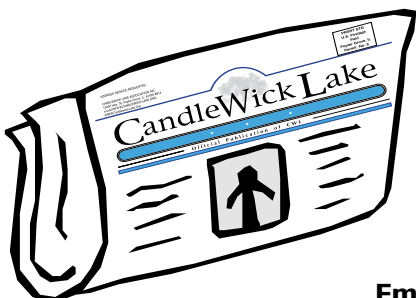
The bins marked for can collection are for CANS ONLY.

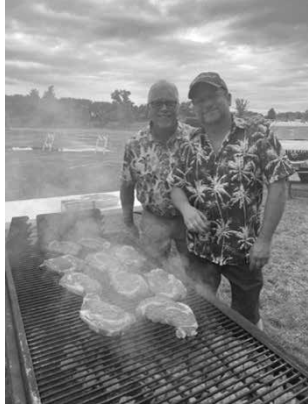

The cruise was a working cruise. We actually helped raise and lower the sails. No luxury here. Rooms were small, four people to a room with bunk beds. We ate meals below deck but had snacks like hot popovers with butter and honey on deck. We'd stop at various ports to explore towns and villages along the coast, but the BEST part? My sister and I were the only two who brought rain gear, so we were the only two on deck (besides the regular crew) who sailed on the rainy days. It was breathtaking; perfect... like our own private cruise.

We drove back to Illinois by way of the Canadian side of Niagara Falls. It was one of our best trips ever!

These recipes reflect the good food and the good times we had on that vacation. Hope you enjoy them too.

Classic Boiled Dinner

Ingredients:

- 1 lemon, quartered
- 4 cloves garlic, peeled- left whole
- 2-3 bay leaves
- 1 tablespoon Creole seasoning (like Tony Chachere's)
- 1/2 to 1 pound multicolored fingerling potatoes (or other small potato of your choice)
- 1 1/2 pounds pink shrimp, in the shell
- 1 package Andouille sausage cut into 2-3 inch lengths
- 1 package corn on the cob (or fresh if it is in season- cob cut into 2 inch segments)



Instructions:

1. Bring a gallon of water to boil in a big pot. Squeeze the lemon into the water and then add the lemon quarters, the garlic, the bay leaves and the Creole seasoning. Simmer all together for a few minutes.
2. Meanwhile, wash the potatoes and rinse the shrimp. Add the potatoes to the water. Simmer until potatoes are almost soft (10 minutes or more, depending on the size of the potatoes.)
3. Add the sausage and the corn and simmer a few minutes. (5-8 minutes or so)
4. Finally add the shrimp and simmer until they turn pink- usually another 2-3 minutes.
5. Dump the whole pot into a large colander, drain and serve on a large platter. Serve with cocktail sauce and Dijon mustard on the side. Pair with a fresh green salad.

Everyone takes as much as they want, they peel their own shrimp as they eat until, you and they are left with nothing but shells and cobs on your plates.

Note: This recipe is actually one of the first recipes I wrote about in our newspaper, but I think it is worth repeating, for its taste as well as ease of preparation and serving. A great meal especially during the hot summer days.

Popovers

Popovers have a magical appeal. Eating one dripping with butter and honey, mmm! This recipe comes from Marion Cunningham and Julia Child.

A good popover is a crisp hollow shell which is well browned and tender. To achieve this, the batter needs to be thoroughly beaten to develop the gluten so that the steam formed during baking will be held in a larger pocket and allow the popovers to rise.



Ingredients:

- 1 cup all purpose flour
- 1 cup milk at room temperature
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 3 large eggs at room temperature
- 2 tablespoon butter, melted
- extra melted butter to grease pans

Instructions:

1. Position oven rack in the lowest rung of the oven and preheat to 425 degrees f. Use extra melted butter to coat nine, 3/4 cup glass custard cups or ten 1/2 cup muffin cups. (If you are using custard cups, place them on a jelly roll pan, leaving space between each cup. If using muffin pans, you'll need two- 12 hole muffin tins, in order to give the popovers ample air circulation, you won't be filling all the holes.)
 2. Pour all the ingredients into the container of a blender and whirl until smooth. (This can also be done in a food processor or in a bowl using a rotary or hand held beater) Strain batter if it is at all lumpy.
- Baking the popovers:**
3. For the custard cups, pour 1/3 cup of batter into each cup, dividing any extra batter among the cups. For the muffin cups, use 1/4 cup of batter for each, filling alternate cups in each tin so that every popover has plenty of "puffing space".
 4. Bake without opening the oven door for 25 minutes, until the popovers are puffed, nicely browned and crisp on the exterior.
 5. Turn the temperature down to 350 degrees f. and bake for another 15-20 minutes to help dry out the interior; which no matter what you do, will always be a little doughy in the center. (Some people love this part, others pull it out) Serve immediately, with butter and honey, jam, maple syrup or your favorite filling.
