Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office. Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.





## From the Table - Just a Bite

August is a time of year when a lot of people take a vacation away from the dog days of Illinois' summer. They fly away to all parts of the US or take a cruise to some more temperate climate.

As for me, I like road trips with a loose itinerary. There's always an ultimate destination, but I like to leave a little room to explore. You never know what you will find along the way.

Back in the day, my sister had a pickup truck with a cap. We traveled all over and slept in the back of the truck. Sometimes we'd deadhead to a specific destination, but other times we'd hear about some out of the way place from a local resident or people we'd meet at campgrounds or rest stops.

Often these places were amazing, but sometimes we'd travel for miles down dusty back roads using sketchy directions trying to find the place they suggested, only to find it closed. (Don't tell anyone but we jumped or climbed over a fence or barricade more than once to satisfy our curiosity...shhhh!)

My sister LOVED that truck- well, I did too, but perhaps not to the same degree as she did. In fact, one time after a long trek to and from one of these remote destinations, we stopped at a campground and all I had on my mind was to chill for a little while before we made dinner. My sister's idea... "Let's just wipe the truck down first. It's all covered with dust and dirt." Really??? Yep! Like I said, she really LOVED that truck!

Personally, I've never had any desire to take a cruise and loll around on a beach all day, but one day I ran across an ad in a magazine for a Fall Wind Jammer Cruise off the coast of Maine. That DID appeal to me! So that fall, my sister and I drove out to Maine and boarded a Three-Masted Schooner to help sail the ocean, explore the Maine coastline and take in the vivid fall colors.

The cruise was a working cruise. We actually helped raise and lower the sails. No luxury here. Rooms were small, four people to a room with bunk beds. We ate meals below deck but had snacks like hot popovers with butter and honey on deck. We'd stop at various ports to explore towns and villages along the coast, but the BEST part? My sister and I were the only two who brought rain gear, so we were the only two on deck (besides the regular crew) who sailed on the rainy days. It was breathtaking; perfect... like our own private cruise.

We drove back to Illinois by way of the Canadian side of Niagara Falls. It was one of our best trips ever!

These recipes reflect the good food and the good times we had on that vacation. Hope you enjoy them too.

#### **Classic Boiled Dinner**

#### **Ingredients:**

1 lemon, quartered

4 cloves garlic, peeled- left whole

2-3 bay leaves

1 tablespoon Creole seasoning (like Tony Chachere's)

1/2 to 1 pound multicolored fingerling potatoes (or other small potato of your choice)

1 1/2 pounds pink shrimp, in the shell

1 package Andouille sausage cut into 2-3 inch lengths

1 package corn on the cob (or fresh if it is in season- cob cut into 2 inch segments)



#### Instructions:

- 1. Bring a gallon of water to boil in a big pot. Squeeze the lemon into the water and then add the lemon quarters, the garlic, the bay leaves and the Creole seasoning. Simmer all together for a few minutes.
- 2. Meanwhile, wash the potatoes and rinse the shrimp. Add the potatoes to the water. Simmer until potatoes are almost soft (10 minutes or more, depending on the size of the potatoes.)
- 3. Add the sausage and the corn and simmer a few minutes. (5-8 minutes or so)
- 4. Finally add the shrimp and simmer until they turn pink- usually another 2-3 min-
- 5. Dump the whole pot into a large colander, drain and serve on a large platter. Serve with cocktail sauce and Dijon mustard on the side. Pair with a fresh green salad.

Everyone takes as much as they want, they peel their own shrimp as they eat until, you and they are left with nothing but shells and cobs on your plates.

Note: This recipe is actually one of the first recipes I wrote about in our newspaper, but I think it is worth repeating, for its taste as well as ease of preparation and serving. A great meal especially during the hot summer days.

#### **Popovers**

Popovers have a magical appeal. Eating one dripping with butter and honey, mmm! This recipe comes from Marion Cunningham and Julia Child.

A good popover is a crisp hollow shell which is well browned and tender. To achieve this, the batter needs to be thoroughly beaten to develop the gluten so that the steam formed during baking will be held in a larger pocket and allow the popovers to rise. **Ingredients:** 

3 large eggs at room temperature 2 tablespoon butter, melted extra melted butter to grease pans

### 1/2 teaspoon salt **Instructions:**

1 cup all purpose flour

1 cup milk at room temperature

- 1. Position oven rack in the lowest rung of the oven and preheat to 425 degrees f. Use extra melted butter to coat nine, 3/4 cup glass custard cups or ten 1/2 cup muffin cups. (If you are using custard cups, place them on a jelly roll pan, leaving space between each cup. If using muffin pans, you'll need two- 12 hole muffin tins, in order to give the popovers ample air circulation, you won't be filling all the holes.)
- 2. Pour all the ingredients into the container of a blender and whirl until smooth. (This can also be done in a food processor or in a bowl using a rotary or hand held beater) Strain batter if it is at all lumpy.

#### Baking the popovers:

- 3. For the custard cups, pour 1/3 cup of batter into each cup, dividing any extra batter among the cups. For the muffin cups, use ½ cup of batter for each, filling alternate cups in each tin so that every popover has plenty of "puffing space".
- 4. Bake without opening the oven door for 25 minutes, until the popovers are puffed, nicely browned and crisp on the exterior.
- 5. Turn the temperature down to 350 degrees f. and bake for another 15-20 minutes to help dry out the interior; which no matter what you do, will always be a little doughy in the center. (Some people love this part, others pull it out) Serve immediately, with butter and honey, jam, maple syrup or your favorite filling.
