# Amenities

## 2022/2023 Amenity Information

**Watercraft Registration & Renewals** Email documents to [cwl@candlewicklake.org](mailto:cwl@candlewicklake.org)

Boats & Personal Watercraft (Jet-skis/Waverunners)

Mail, email, or drop off your current registration, proof of \$100,000.00 liability insurance, and the completed watercraft registration form and a new decal will be issued.

Maximum boat length is 20' and there is a 90 HP limit on all motors operating on the lake.

There is no charge for the decal. All watercraft not registered to your Candlewick Lake address in 2021 must be inspected by Public Safety before it goes on the lake. All motorized watercrafts are required to be registered, have a new decal displayed every year, and have the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL displayed on both sides of the watercraft.

Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office.

Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.

Anyone age 16 and over is required to always have an Illinois Fishing License and a Candlewick Guest Fishing Permit in their immediate possession while fishing at Candlewick Lake. Active-duty military personnel and disabled veterans need to present a Military ID in lieu of an Illinois Fishing License and Candlewick Guest Fishing Pass.

## 2022/2023 Member ID Card

### Information

It is not necessary to renew your Member ID card if your Member ID card has your date of birth printed on it. 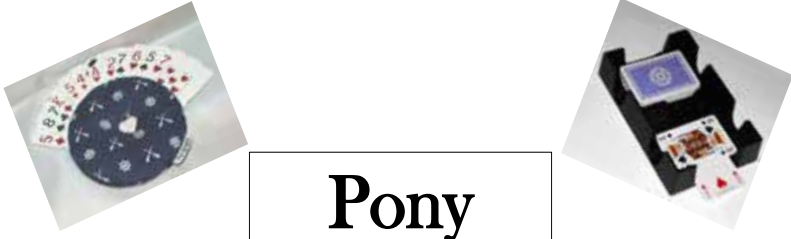

# Information

## From the Table - Just a Bite

**Celebrate! Celebrate!...** But cooks need time to dance to the music too! Party foods don't have to be complicated and time consuming to prepare. Simple ingredients can taste delicious, look spectacular and make a cook's life easier in this season of celebrations.

It's always great to find quick and easy recipes that help take the stress out of entertaining. Finger foods that can be prepared ahead or assembled at the last minute can be a great help. Serving them in a variety of different or individual containers can provide a fun and creative way for both guest and host to enjoy the festivities together.

Here are some recipes I hope you will enjoy.



### Antipasto Skewers

Use your favorite meats and cheese, vegetables and relishes for your perfect antipasto skewer. Here are a few suggestions of what you might use:

20 wooden skewers      20 green olives      1lb. sliced salami  
 ½ lb. sliced pepperoni      20 black olives      1lb. Monterey Jack cheese, cubed

1. On a wooden skewer, thread a green olive. Fold a slice of salami in half and then in half again; skewer through all of the folded layers. Add a cube of cheese. Fold a pepperoni slice in half and then in half again; skewer through all of the layers. Add another cheese cube, a salami slice and a black olive. Repeat using remaining skewers and ingredients.
2. Serve the skewers in a clear glass or acrylic container filled with rock salt to hold skewers upright.

**Bloody Mary** is it a drink or a snack or both?



### Bloody Mary Drink Mix

\*The easiest is to buy your favorite Bloody Mary Mix at the store, but if you want to make your own- voila!

1- 46 oz bottle hot style or regular vegetable juice  
 ½ cup lemon juice      1 tablespoon prepared horseradish  
 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce      1 teaspoon celery salt

1. For the mix, in a large pitcher combine all of the ingredients, Cover and chill until ready to serve.
2. For each drink, pour ½ cup drink mix into a glass filled with ice and the desired amount of vodka and garnishes.

### Bloody Mary Dip

Makes 1 ¼ cup

8 ounces of cream cheese softened      ¼ cup of vegetable juice cocktail  
 2 teaspoons prepared horseradish      1 teaspoon celery salt  
 1 teaspoon dried chives      1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

Black pepper and hot pepper sauce to taste.

1. In a small bowl, beat cream cheese with an electric mixer until fluffy. Gradually beat in vegetable juice cocktail. Stir in remaining ingredients. Divide mixture among shot glasses. Cover and refrigerate for at least one hour. When ready to serve, place an assortment of dippers for guest to select to put in their shot glasses.
2. For the drink or the dip you can prepare the basic drink or dip and let the guest select the garnishes and dippers. Half of the fun of a Bloody Mary is in the garnishes and the flavor combinations.

Garnishes and Dippers for either recipe

Briny> green olives, dill pickles, pepperoncini peppers, cornichons, pickled okra

Salty> crispy bacon, summer sausage, beef jerky, cheese cubes

Sweet> cocktail shrimp, baby corn

Veggies> carrot slices or sticks, celery sticks, Sweet pepper strips, cherry tomatoes, cucumber, slices or spears

Assorted Crackers > for dip

### Cheesecake Shots

(This recipe makes 2 different flavored shots- 6 of each flavor) You will need 12- plastic or glass 2 oz. cordial glasses or shot glasses.

Ingredients:

16 oz. cream cheese, softened  
 ¾ cup sugar  
 1 tablespoon coffee flavored liqueur or 1 teaspoon chocolate extract  
 2 teaspoons grated lemon peel  
 4 tablespoons chocolate cookie crumbs  
 Chocolate covered coffee beans or grated chocolate  
 4 tablespoons graham cracker crumbs  
 Blueberries and raspberries

Instructions:

1. In a large bowl, beat cream cheese and sugar with an electric mixer on medium speed until smooth.
2. Divide mixture in half: place in separate bowls.
3. Stir coffee liqueur (or chocolate extract) in one of the bowls of cream cheese mixture

and stir the lemon peel in the other bowl of cream cheese mixture.

**For the Chocolate Shots:**

4. Spoon 2 teaspoons of chocolate cookie crumbs into the bottoms of 6-2 oz. shot glasses.
5. Top with 2 tablespoons of the coffee liqueur cream cheese mixture.
6. Sprinkle with 2 teaspoons cookie crumbs and another 2 tablespoons coffee liqueur cream cheese mixture.
7. Top with a coffee bean or grated chocolate.

**For the Lemon Shots:**

8. Spoon 2 teaspoons graham cracker crumbs into the bottom of 6- 2 oz. cordial glasses.
9. Top with 2 tablespoons of the lemon cream cheese mixture.
10. Sprinkle with 2 teaspoons graham cracker crumbs and another 2 tablespoons cream cheese mixture.
11. Top with blue berries and/ or raspberries.
12. Refrigerate desserts or at least 30 minutes before serving.

### Jelled Champagne Dessert

1 tablespoon unflavored gelatin  
 2 cups cold white grape juice, divided  
 2 tablespoons sugar  
 2 cups champagne or club soda  
 8 fresh strawberries.

1. In a small saucepan, sprinkle gelatin over 1 cup of cold white grape juice and let stand for 1 minute. Heat over low heat, stirring until gelatin is completely dissolved. Stir in sugar. Remove from heat; stir in remaining grape juice. Cool to room temperature.
2. Transfer gelatin mixture to a large bowl. Slowly stir in champagne or club soda. Pour half the mixture into 8 champagne or parfait glasses. Add one strawberry to each glass. Chill glasses and remaining gelatin mixture until almost set; about 1 hour.
3. Place the reserved gelatin mixture in a blender, cover and process until foamy. Pour equally into the glasses. Chill for 3 hours or until set.

## CWL Dog Park Rules & Regulations

1. Purpose: The Candlewick Lake Dog Park (the "Dog Park"), as identified by the Board, has been developed to give Members a place where the dogs of Residents can run free. For everyone's safety and enjoyment, you and your dog(s) are required to adhere to the following rules and regulations while visiting the Dog Park.

2. Rules and Regulations:

- 2.1 Use of the Dog Park is prohibited unless the Resident using the Dog Park has purchased the required tag (the "Tag").
- 2.2 To obtain a dog park tag, all dogs must have proof of a current up-to-date rabies tag. It is recommended that dogs be current on all their shots; especially kennel cough, distemper, parvovirus and a yearly fecal exam.
- 2.3 Residents will pay \$10/dog/year for a Tag. Fees are based on a fiscal year (May 1-April 30), and not when the Tag is purchased. **There will be a \$5 replacement fee for lost tags.**
- 2.4 Residents purchasing tags must read the Dog Park Rules and Regulations (collectively the "Dog Park Rules") and agree in writing that they understand and assume all responsibility for the risk associated with using this facility.
- 2.5 Tags may be revoked and/or fines charged for non-adherence to the Dog Park Rules, and/or if the Resident is not in good standing with the Association.
- 2.6 The Dog Park is divided into two areas: one area is for dogs weighing 25 lbs and under; and the other area is for all dogs.
- 2.7 Dog park hours are from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. or dusk, whichever is later. Public Safety will lock and unlock the Dog Park daily. The Association reserves the right to change, at any time, the times and days the Dog Park is open.

3. Usage Rules:

- 3.1 Use of the Dog Park is restricted only to members and their dogs that have been issued proper, valid, and current Tags. Use of the Dog Park by those that do not have a current Tag is prohibited, although more than one person may be present for each dog.
- 3.2 Uses of the Dog Park for anything other than personal/residential use of the Dog Park with a dog with a valid Tag is prohibited, including but not limited to dog training classes, solicitation of dogs, and other similar uses.
- 3.3 Dogs must be under control and in the sight of the user at all times. The user shall be and remain responsible for the behavior of the user's dog(s).
- 3.4 If a user's dog is aggressive, the user must leash the dog. Said leash shall not exceed seven feet in length. The user agrees that the user will address any aggressive behavior before it escalates. If the dog is still aggressive after reasonable steps have been timely taken, the user agrees to remove the user's dog(s) promptly. **If aggressive dog owner refuses to remove aggressive dog it is the right of other dog owners to call Public Safety. Public Safety will use their discretion to rectify the situation.**
- 3.5 Candlewick Lake reserves the right, at any time, with or without written notice, to refuse to issue, and/or revoke the Tags of dogs displaying aggression or intimidating behavior towards other dogs or people. No refunds will be given for revoked Tags. Candlewick Lake **Rec Manager** is hereby empowered to make these decisions in their discretion.
- 3.6 Registration and rabies tags must be worn on all dog collars and visible at all times when using the Dog Park.
- 3.7 In the event of a dog bite or other injury, each user who is involved, either on their own or through their dog(s), shall exchange Tag and other reasonably-required information such as a name, telephone number, and address.
- 3.8 By their use of the Dog Park, users stipulate and agree that they know and understand that not all dogs like other dogs. Users agree to research methods to help understand dog behavior and socialization as needed. Users also acknowledge by their use of the Dog Park that some dogs

growl when they play with other dogs, and thus just because one dog is growling does not mean that it is necessarily being aggressive.

- 3.9 Absolutely no food is allowed to be brought into the Dog Park, including but not limited to dog treats. All dogs have great sniffers and can become aggressive **even** when food is in a pocket.
  - 3.10 The maximum number of dogs that any one user may bring to the Dog Park at the same time is four.
  - 3.11 Users must carry a leash and a cleanup bag at all times when using the Dog Park. Users are required to immediately pick up after their dog(s). All dog waste must be disposed of properly in onsite refuse containers if available. If such containers are not onsite and able to be used, the user shall dispose of the waste in a proper manner offsite, for it shall not be an excuse that the Association containers are not onsite and able to be used. Users are encouraged to clean up the waste of others if they see one to help keep the area clean.
  - 3.12 All objects used for dogs such as tennis balls, frisbees, and other dog toys must be removed when leaving the Dog Park. The Association reserves the right to discard any such objects left at the Dog Park.
  - 3.13 Users must be 16 years of age or older. Users between the ages of 11 and 15 must be accompanied by an adult. Children age 10 and under are not allowed at the Dog Park. Users hereby acknowledge, by their use of the Dog Park, that the restriction of Children age 10 and under is for their own protection.
  - 3.14 Male dogs must be neutered. Female dogs in heat are not allowed inside the Dog Park. No dogs under 6 months of age are allowed.
  - 3.15 Smoking and/or consumption of alcohol beverages are both strictly prohibited.
  - 3.16 Non-member dogs are not allowed in the Dog Park. Users allowing non-member dogs into the dog park may have their Tags revoked.
  - 3.17 Users are discouraged from allowing their dogs from standing at or near the gate as people are trying to enter. Users agree to not enter if another dog is at the gate unattended.
4. Additional Provisions:
- 4.1 All users of the Dog Park, by virtue of their use thereof, acknowledge their notice that the Dog Park is not supervised, and that use is at the user's own risk. To the fullest extent allowed by law, users of the Dog Park, by virtue of their use thereof, stipulate and agree that Candlewick Lake Association is not responsible for injury or damage to any user, dog, animal, or other property, and waive any and all claims they may have against Candlewick Lake Association (including employees, officers, directors, and agents thereof) related to the use of the Dog Park.
  - 4.2 Nothing contained herein shall be construed to limit, alter, or otherwise restrict the applicability of other rules, regulations, and restrictions on pets in Candlewick Lake.
  - 4.3 The Association reserves the right to, at any time, amend these Rules and Regulations, close (temporarily and/or permanently) the Dog Park, and impose additional rules and regulations. In such event or events, there shall be no redress or compensation to anyone as a result of such event or events, including but not limited to those persons that have purchased tags.
  - 4.4 In the event one or more provisions contained herein is now or in the future violates any applicable rule, regulation, statute, law, or other applicable provision of the law, said provision(s) shall be automatically amended to the least extent possible to bring said provision(s) into compliance with the law. In the event a person that has been issued a Tag is aware (or believes) that of a provision contained herein violates the law, it is the responsibility of said person to timely notify the Association of such knowledge or belief as a pre-condition to any request for redress due to such actual or alleged violation.

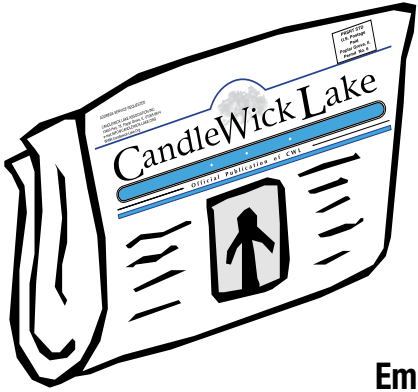

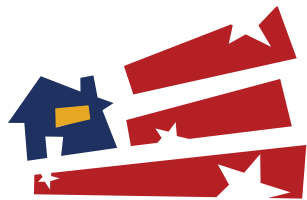
