and the completed watercraft registration form and a new decal will be issued. Maximum boat length is 20' and there is a 90 HP limit on all motors operating on the lake.

There is no charge for the decal. All watercraft not registered to your Candlewick Lake address in 2022 must be inspected by Public Safety before it goes on the lake. All motorized watercrafts are required to be registered, have a new decal displayed every year, and have the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL displayed on both sides of the watercraft.

Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office. Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.

As we start the new year, we are thankful for the many exciting changes in process at Savannah Oaks.

Savannah Oaks has become the gathering place for everyone in our community by creating a welcoming atmosphere with activities for golfers and non-golfers to enjoy. Club Manager, Alex Leske and his staff, along with the Golf Commission, are continually investigating ways to improve our facility, activities and amenities.

Before we highlight the new things, let's reflect on the successes in 2023.

- We had more golfers hitting the links this season. In 2023 we had 11,335 golfers which is 2,224 more golfers than in 2022. Total revenues from golf were \$102,853, an increase of \$23,257 from the previous year.
- We saw more participation in our non-golf activities including Pub Trivia, Bingo, Bags Tournaments, TV Sporting Events, along with our favorite special event parties including Cinco De Mayo, Daytona 500, Halloween, and New Year's Eve, The 2,525 participates brought in \$ 37,334 in revenue.



From the Table - Just a Bite By S.L. Bartels, Drew Ct.

A Bit About All Things Edible

I read cookbooks like most people read mysteries. I'm always on the lookout for interesting recipes, but also for fun food facts and interesting back stories about all things edible. For example:

All parts of a chili are HOT! It is often thought that the seeds are hotter than the flesh. However, according to Cook's Magazine, when they tested all parts of the chili separately, they found most of the capsaicin (heat) is concentrated in the whitish pith, with progressively smaller amounts in the seeds (73mg) and (512 mg) in the flesh.

You can tame the heat in a dish that is too spicy by adding ingredients from the opposite end of the flavor spectrum. Creating the balance depends on the recipe. You may add a fat such as butter, oil, cream, sour cream or cheese OR something sweet such as honey sugar or syrup. You would make your selection based on what would work best with the other components in the dish.

Items that stay fresher in the freezer: bay leaves, whole wheat flour, nuts & seeds, yeast and butter.

Rejuvenating crystallized honey. Remove lid from glass honey jar. Place honey jar in a saucepan with 1 inch of water and gently heat over low heat until honey is smooth. **To prevent re-crystallization**, stir in 2 teaspoons light corn syrup per 1 cup honey before transferring honey to a clean jar. The corn syrup inhibits crystals from reforming.

How to revive wilted produce. Leafy Greens- such as lettuce, spinach, arugula. Soak greens in ice water for 30 minutes and drain.

Vegetable Stalks- such as broccoli, asparagus, celery, scallions or parsley. Trim off bottoms of stalks or stems on a bias. This exposes more stem/stalk capillaries which will allow more water to be wicked back into the vegetable. Stand produce in a container filled with ice water for 1 hour.

Re-baking under baked cookies. Sometimes cookies appear to be baked but remain raw or doughy in the center. The sources I've read suggest lowering the baking temperature by 50 degrees f. and re-baking them by the entire time listed in the recipe. The drawback is that the center will be cooked but the longer time will crisp the edges more.


