Watercraft Registration & Renewals Email documents to cwl@candlewicklake.org
Boats & Personal Watercraft (Jet-skis/Waverunners)

Mail, email, or drop off your current registration, proof of \$100,000.00 liability insurance, and the completed watercraft registration form and a new decal will be issued.

Maximum boat length is 20' and there is a 90 HP limit on all motors operating on the lake.

There is no charge for the decal. All watercraft not registered to your Candlewick Lake address in 2021 must be inspected by Public Safety before it goes on the lake. All motorized watercrafts are required to be registered, have a new decal displayed every year, and have the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL displayed on both sides of the watercraft.

Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office.

Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.

Dog Park Registration

Guest Fishing Passes Email pass request form to cwl@candlewicklake.org

Anyone age 16 and over is required to always have an Illinois Fishing License and a Candlewick Guest Fishing Permit in their immediate possession while fishing at Candlewick Lake. Active-duty military personnel and disabled veterans need to present a Military ID in lieu of an Illinois Fishing License and Candlewick Guest Fishing Pass.

Guest Pool Passes Residents must be with their guests while at the Candlewick Lake Pool.

Children age 9 and younger must be accompanied by a chaperone that is at least 16 years old.

Annual Pass (Valid May 28th – September 5th) \$30.00 each - Limit 4 per household

Daily Pass \$5.00 each Your Member ID serves as your Resident Pool Pass.

Information

It is not necessary to renew your Member ID card if your Member ID card has your date of birth printed on it. 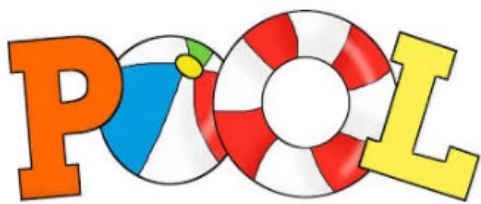

33rd Annual CWL Catch and Release Bass Tournament Saturday, June 11, 2022

Come join the fun and competition with fellow residents. Interpretation of these rules will be left exclusively to tournament officials whose decision is final.

Pre-Tournament meeting at 6:15am behind Rec Center. Tournament hours 6:30am to 1:00pm.

Eligibility: The tournament consists of up to 30 two man teams fishing from Candlewick lake registered boats. All teams shall consist of a minimum of one association member or special family member (mother, father, son, daughter, grandchildren). All qualifying members must be in good standing. All participants must have valid Illinois fishing licenses. No Candlewick permit is required for non-members during the tournament. This year 2 Kayakers can join as partners providing one of them has a working live-well.

Entry Fee: \$80.00 per team. Please bring \$20 bills in cash for easy distribution of prize money.

Big Bass Pot: An optional \$20.00 entry fee per boat is required to enter the big bass pot. 100% pay back to the team with the largest bass.

Prizes: 100% of entry fee will be awarded as prize money. Top 20% of field will receive prizes. Tie breaker shall be the team with the single largest bass or the team that weighs the most bass. If still tied a coin toss will take place.

Sportsmanship: Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety, and conservation are expected from each contestant. Any infraction of these fundamental sporting principles may be deemed cause for disqualification. Official Checkpoint: tournament will start and end behind the rec center. Anglers may not leave the boat except in a case of emergency (restroom, medical reasons, Etc.) Boat Inspection: Each boat will be inspected prior to tournament take off and all compartments will be checked for fish, alcohol, etc. No Wake: the lake is no wake the entire time of the tournament. Boat length is 20 feet max. Scoring: Final winners will be determined by total weight of each team's catch. Only largemouth and smallmouth bass will be weighed. Tournament limit shall be 6 fish per team, bass must measure 14" or more with mouth closed and the tail fanned. BASS PRESENTED TO WEIGH WHICH FAIL TO MEASURE 14" WILL MEAN IMMEDIATE TEAM DISQUALIFICATION. A courtesy bump board will be available prior to weigh-in to check questionable fish before submitting them for official measure. Care of Fish: Each boat must be equipped with a functional live well, large enough to maintain a live limit of bass for both contestants using the boat. Additionally, the use of chemical live well additive is strongly recommended. Contestants shall use reasonable care in handling fish to keep them alive and in good condition. Any Contestant caught mistreating a fish will be disqualified. Fish should be kept in live wells until weigh-in. Dead Fish Penalty: There will be a dead fish penalty of 1/2 of that fish's weight. Fishing Method: Only artificial lures may be used. No live or prepared bait will be allowed with the exception of pork strips, rinds, etc. Only one rod may be used at a time; however others may be rigged and ready. No trolling is allowed. Please allow reasonable casting distance between boats. Weigh-In: Weigh-in will take place at the conclusion of the tournament only. Weigh-In bags will be furnished and must be used by all contestants. Contestants are responsible for their catch from the boat to the check-in. All fish weighed become property of CWL lake management and will be returned to the lake. Late Penalty: Competitors must be at 6:15 meeting and weigh-in on time or be disqualified. No excuses.

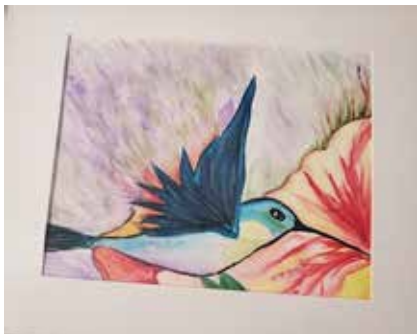

Information

From the Table - Just a Bite

It's June and cold weather is over. But it's hard to tell if it is spring or summer! It seems that when winter closed its door, spring and summer couldn't quite decide which one should come through the door next.

But wherever the temperatures take us, this time of year I always look forward to fresh spring vegetables, and one of my favorites is asparagus. Sometimes when I go to the market the stalks are thin, other times very fat. I have wondered... is one better than the other?

It turns out that the diameter is determined by two factors, the variety and the age of the entire plant. Whatever the variety, younger asparagus beds produce thinner spears. Older, more established beds will produce the fatter spears. An asparagus plant can produce for up to 20 years. But no matter what the size, they taste alike; although there may be a slight difference in texture. Some say, larger spears seem to be less fibrous. Your choice of size may have more to do with the cooking method you choose. Thicker spears may work better for broiling, roasting or grilling because of the intense dry heat; while the thinner spears may provide better results with steaming, boiling, stir frying or sautéing. (Sautéed with a bit of olive oil and salt- yum!)

The recipe I'm sharing this month comes together pretty quickly with just a handful of ingredients.

Fuseli with Asparagus and Bacon

Serves 4

Ingredients:

4 oz. sliced bacon, cut crosswise into 1/2 inch pieces

2 tablespoons olive oil

1 medium onion, finely chopped

2 pounds asparagus, hard ends trimmed off and stalks

cut along the diagonal into 1/2 inch slices

salt and pepper

1 pound Fuseli (short corkscrew pasta)

1/2 cup finely grated Parmigiano-reggiano cheese plus additional for serving

(You can also use just Parmigiano if you prefer)



Instructions:

1. Cook bacon in a 12" heavy skillet over moderately high heat, stirring occasionally until browned and crisp, about 6 minutes. Transfer bacon with a slotted spoon to paper towel to drain.
2. Pour off all but 2 tablespoons of bacon fat from the skillet. Then add the olive oil and onion to the skillet and cook, stirring occasionally, until the onion is golden-about 4 minutes.
3. Add the asparagus to the skillet of onions and sauté, stirring until it is tender-crisp about 4-5 minutes. Season with salt and pepper.
4. While onion is cooking, cook pasta in 6-8 qt. pot of boiling, salted* water until pasta is al dente.
5. Reserve 1 cup pasta water** and drain pasta in colander.
6. Return drained pasta to the same 6-8 qt. pot.
7. Add the asparagus mixture to this pot along with 1/2 cup of pasta water and cheese.
8. Add the other 1/2 cup of pasta water to the sauté skillet and deglaze by bringing water to a boil, stirring and scraping up brown bits from the bottom of the skillet-about 1 minute.
9. Add contents of deglazed skillet to the pasta and toss together. Warm over moderately low heat until well combined, about 30 seconds. Serve pasta sprinkled with bacon and with additional cheese on the side. Enjoy!

* Use 1 tablespoon salt for every 4 quarts of water- when you cook the pasta.

** I usually save 2 cups of pasta water- the additional cup is just in case I need to adjust the "sauce"- some pasta absorbs liquids more than others in which case I add more, a little at a time until I get the consistency that appeals to me.
