Watercraft Registration & Renewals Email documents to cwl@candlewicklake.org
Boats & Personal Watercraft (Jet-skis/Waverunners)

Mail, email, or drop off your current registration, proof of \$100,000.00 liability insurance,

and the completed watercraft registration form and a new decal will be issued.

Maximum boat length is 20' and there is a 90 HP limit on all motors operating on the lake.

There is no charge for the decal. All watercraft not registered to your Candlewick Lake address in 2022 must be inspected by Public Safety before it goes on the lake. All motorized watercrafts are required to be registered, have a new decal displayed every year, and have the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL displayed on both sides of the watercraft.

Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office. Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.

Anyone age 16 and over is required to always have an Illinois Fishing License and a Candlewick Guest Fishing Permit in their immediate possession while fishing at Candlewick Lake. Active-duty military personnel and disabled veterans need to present a Military ID in lieu of an Illinois Fishing License and Candlewick Guest Fishing Pass.

Information

From the Table - Just a Bite

This is the month we celebrate the long awaited Pi Day! Oh, you ask, "What is it? Why is it important? And how the heck is it celebrated?" Well, March 14th is the celebration of the mathematical sign pi, one of the world's most important mathematical constants. The date written numerically as 3/14 matches the first three digits of pi which is actually a never ending number, but it has been abbreviated for problem solving to 3.14



So why is pi considered to be such an important symbol? Scientists knew for centuries that, regardless of the size of a circle, the circumference and diameter always had the same exact ratio. The Greek mathematician Archimedes created an algorithm which accurately approximated the value of pi. Why is **that** important?

Pi is used in countless calculations that touch every aspect of our lives. It's been used to help find and calculate the orbit of planets in the solar system, examine how ripples in rivers carry energy, used in mathematics, physics and engineering for construction and architecture, music theory, GPS technology, agriculture and the world of food.

Pi is a circle's circumference-(the distance around it)-divided by its diameter, (the distance across the center). The relationship holds true no matter the size of the circle. The rim of a soup can and a planet's equator both yield the ratio of pi.

So, how did the celebration begin? Pi Day was first celebrated in 1988 at San Francisco's Exploratorium, "a museum of science and technology that encourages visitors to be hands-on". The holiday was founded by physicist Larry Shaw. It has been said he liked to combine crazy, fun ideas with science and math, so he proposed a way for science and fun to come together, culminating in the birth of Pi Day.

Then on March 12, 2009 the U.S. House of Representatives passed a resolution recognizing March 14 as National Pi Day.

Pi Day has been observed in many ways, including eating pie, throwing pies and competitions as to who can recall pi to the highest number of decimal places. (As of 2010, pi was calculated to 2.7 trillion digits and still counting.)

As for me, I prefer celebrating by eating pie. But just like pi, we have an inordinate number of pies in some form or fashion from which to choose: fruit pies, cream pies, vegetable pies, meat pies, hand pies, moon pies, whoopee pies, ice cream pies, pizza pies, shepherd pie... For a simple & sweet way to celebrate Pi Day, try Pocket Pies. Thank You Larry Shaw!



Pocket Pies

Pie Crust Ingredients:

- 2 1/2 cups all purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup cold butter, cut into pieces
- 8-10 tablespoons ice water



Pie Crust Instructions:

1. Combine the first 3 ingredients in a bowl with a pastry blender or fork until mixture resembles small peas.
2. Sprinkle ice water over the mixture in the bowl (1 tablespoon at a time); stir with a fork after each addition until dry ingredients are moistened and come together.
3. Divide in half and shape each half into a ball. Cover each ball with plastic and chill for 30 minutes.

Filling Ingredients:

- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
- 9 tablespoons jam or preserves

Assembly Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees F.
2. Roll one ball of dough into 1/8 inch thickness on a lightly floured surface. Cut into 6 rounds using a 4" round cutter. Repeat with second ball of dough.
3. Place 6 rounds two inches apart on a parchment lined baking sheet.
4. Spoon 1 1/2 tablespoons preserves or jam in the center of each round; moisten edges with water. Top with the remaining 6 rounds of dough. Press edges together with fork tines to seal. Cut slits on top to let steam escape.
5. Bake at 425 degrees f. for 15 minutes or until golden brown.
6. Stir together sugar and cinnamon and sprinkle over warm pies.

Option: Instead of cutting dough into rounds, try cutting it into squares or triangles to give some variety to your pocket pies. Enjoy!
