You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office. Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.







From the Table - Just a Bite

It's May! There are all sorts of fun food days that are celebrated nationally for the whole month of May: Cheese, Hamburger, Salsa, Craft Beer are just the tip of the iceberg. By a happy coincidence, this month has a wonderful day to celebrate all of these particular items on the same day - Cinco de Mayo.

A perfect day for a Nacho Bar! Chips, Queso, Salsa and plenty of toppings for guests to create their own perfect Nacho plate.

Start with plenty of tortilla chips and then add your favorite components. Use premade products and/or your favorite recipes or try some new ones.

Here are some that we enjoy.





Slow Cooker Queso

Serves 6 to 8

Ingredients

1 pound Velveeta, cut into large cubes

1 pound pepper jack cheese, shredded (about 4 cups)

2 cups whole milk

1 teaspoon ground cumin

Directions

- 1. Combine all of the ingredients in a small slow cooker.
- 2. Cook on low 1 ½ hours.
- 3. Uncover and stir well until completely smooth. If the queso is still lumpy, cover and continue cooking on low and stirring every 15 minutes until the cheese is completely melted and smooth.

Guacamole

Makes 2 cups

Ingredients

- 3 large ripe avocados
- 3 scallions, minced
- 1 garlic clove, crushed
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 tablespoon sour cream
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoon lemon juice
- ½ teaspoon cayenne pepper

Directions

- 1. Halve the avocados and remove the pits. Peel the halves. Put the avocado flesh in a bowl.
- 2. Mash the avocado coarsely with a fork Add the scallions, garlic, olive oil, sour cream, salt and lemon juice, mash together. Be sure not to over work, small chunks of avocado should still remain. Adjust the seasoning if necessary, with salt and lemon juice. Transfer the mixture to a serving bowl. Sprinkle top with cayenne pepper, and serve the dip immediately. If making dip ahead, lay plastic wrap directly on the guacamole surface to prevent air from discoloring it.

Tomato Salsa

Makes approximately 3 cups

Ingredients

- 1 Fresh Serrano chili pepper (or pepper of your choice) seeded and finely chopped
- 1 garlic clove- minced

½ onion, chopped

3 scallions, chopped

½ cup fresh cilantro leaves- coarsely chopped

1 ½ lbs. ripe tomatoes, seeded and diced.

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 tablespoons lime juice
- ½ teaspoon salt or more to taste

3 tablespoons water

Directions

- 1. Combine the Serrano pepper, garlic, onion, scallions and cilantro together in a bowl.
- 2. Add the tomatoes, olive oil, lime juice, salt and water, mix together. Adjust seasonings to taste.
- 3. Transfer to a bowl. Let stand for at least 30 minutes before serving to allow flavors to develop. (This salsa is best served the day it is made.)
- * This also makes a great mango salsa; just replace the tomatoes with mangos. Any left-over mango salsa stands up well when covered and refrigerated.

Add other favorites to the bar: black olives, Pico de Gallo, refried beans, Beef-Chorizo topping and more. Then belly up to the bar and start creating your hand picked, perfect Nacho meal! Oh wait, not yet, don't forget your beer. (I mean, cerveza) Ahhhhh...
