## 2022/2023 Amenity Information <u>Watercraft Registration & Renewals</u> Email documents to cwl@candlewicklake.org

Boats & Personal Watercraft (Jet-skis/Waverunners)

Mail, email, or drop off your current registration, proof of \$100,000.00 liability insurance, and the completed watercraft registration form and a new decal will be issued. Maximum boat length is 20' and there is a 90 HP limit on all motors operating on the

There is no charge for the decal. All watercraft not registered to your Candlewick Lake address in 2021 must be inspected by Public Safety before it goes on the lake. All motorized watercrafts are required to be registered, have a new decal displayed every year, and have the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL displayed on both sides of the watercraft.

Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office. Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.

## From the Table - Just a Bite

Bean Me Up Scotty!

This month's recipe takes you on an enterprising Voyage; Boldly using ingredients you may never have used together before...

Ok, you got me! I am a Trekkie. And, yes I did (kind of) steal um... borrow that line. But I thought it would be a fun way to introduce a spicy bean filled soup recipe I received from one of my fellow Communications Committee members, not mentioning any names (Bonnie).

After all, I suspect readers of this monthly column are here to explore strange new ingredients, to seek out new flavors and new recipes, to boldly go where they have never gone before - food wise that is.

Ok, Ok, I'll stop with the Trekkie References.

#### 7 Can Soup

Serves 5

The original recipe comes from the Professionally Cooking web site. "The actual taste is a cross between tortilla soup and chili."

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1 (15 oz) can black beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 (15 oz) can pinto beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 (14.5 oz) can petite diced tomatoes
- 1 (15 oz) can sweet corn, drained
- 1 (12.5 oz) can chicken breast, drained and flaked
- 1 large (28 oz) container green enchilada sauce
- 1 (14 oz) can chicken broth
- 1 (1 oz) packet taco seasoning
- 1/2 teaspoon cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon chili powder
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

Optional toppings:

Shredded cheese Lime Wedges
Tortilla chips Dab of sour cream

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Combine all the canned ingredients, taco seasoning, cumin, chili powder and garlic into a large pot on the stove-top.
- 2. Bring the soup to a boil over medium high heat.
- 3. Reduce heat and simmer 20-25 minutes.
- 4. Serve warm with your choice of shredded cheese, tortilla chips lime wedges and sour cream or perhaps some beer bread.

#### **Beer Bread**

One of the easiest breads you can make **Ingredients:** 

3 cups self-rising flour

3 tablespoons sugar

12 ounces beer, at room temperature

4 tablespoons butter, melted

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Grease a 9 x 5 loaf pan with butter. Preheat oven to 350°F.
- 2. Stir flour and sugar together. Pour in beer and stir until foaming subsides and flour is incorporated. Spoon into prepared pan and bake for 50–60 minutes until a toothpick comes out clean or an instant-read thermometer reads about 190°F.
- 3. Immediately remove from pan and set on a wire rack on top of a rimmed baking sheet. Pour melted butter over the top and brush sides.
- 4. Let bread cool for 15 minutes or so, then serve warm. Once the bread is completely cooled, it can be sliced to use for sandwiches, toasted, or served plain.

## If you don't have self rising flour you can make your own self-rising flour at home. Just use this <u>basic formula</u>:

For every 1 cup of all-purpose flour, add 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder and 1/4 teaspoon fine salt. Whisk the ingredients thoroughly in a large bowl or put them in a glass jar and shake well. Store your self-rising flour in an airtight container in the pantry. (Be sure to label it, so you know it contains a leavening agent.) Use within six months or the baking powder will start to lose its potency.


