Mail, email, or drop off your current registration, proof of \$100,000.00 liability insurance.

and the completed watercraft registration form and a new decal will be issued. Maximum boat length is 20' and there is a 90 HP limit on all motors operating on the lake.

There is no charge for the decal. All watercraft not registered to your Candlewick Lake address in 2022 must be inspected by Public Safety before it goes on the lake. All motorized watercrafts are required to be registered, have a new decal displayed every year, and have the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL displayed on both sides of the watercraft.

Guest watercraft are not allowed.

Canoes, Kayaks and other Non-Motorized Watercraft

Non-motorized watercraft that are not required to be registered with the State, must display the member's unit and lot number preceded by CWL on both sides of the watercraft. You do not need to register non-motorized watercraft at the office. Candlewick decals are not required for non-motorized watercraft.







# From the Table - Just a Bite

#### It's September and I'm Just Chicken things Out...

This month's article is the result of this text that I read on a shirt while visiting the Boone County Fair last month... The shirt made me laugh but also reminded me that sometimes there are amazing stories and histories behind things that are common place in our lives that we take for granted. So I asked some questions and learned a few things about poultry in general and chickens in particular.

Poultry refers to fowl raised for meat or eggs and include chickens, ducks, turkeys, pigeons, geese, pheasants, quail, ostriches and emus (Emus? Who knew?).

- By 3000 BC- Egyptians had domesticated fowl for the eggs they laid.
- Chicken and turkey flocks establish a pecking order which determines dominance for priority over food and nesting.
- There are more than 300 breeds of chickens but only a few are used for meat production.
- A single hen can produce 250-300 eggs per year.
- Illinois has over 500 million chickens that produce almost 130 million dozen eggs yearly.
- Chicken is the #1 protein consumed in the U S.

I have to admit that chicken is served at our home quite often in a variety of ways. Here are two.

#### **Moo Shu Chicken Ingredients:**

- 1 tbsp Asian sesame oil
- 1 bag (10 oz.) shredded cole slaw mix
- 1 bag (8 oz.) shredded carrots
- 4 scallions sliced

3 cups shredded cooked chicken (from a rotisserie chicken)

#### **Directions:**

- In a large non stick skillet, heat the oil over medium heat, Add 1. the cole slaw mix, carrots, scallions and garlic. Cook, stirring occasionally, about 8 minutes or until vegetables are softened.
- Stir in the Hoisen sauce and soy sauce and cook for 2 minutes. 2. Add the shredded chicken: stir to combine with the vegetables and heat through.



3. To serve, Heat the tortillas following package directions. Spoon about 1/2 cup of the chicken mixture down the center of each tortilla. Roll up. Serve immediately. Makes 10 rolls.

#### **Quick Chicken Mole**

#### Makes 4 servings

- **Ingredients:**
- 2 tsp olive oil
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 2 tsp chili powder
- 1 tbsp tomato paste 1/4 cup raisins

1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon 1 1/4 cups chicken broth

1 tbsp creamy peanut butter

- 2 tsp. unsweetened cocoa powder 1 rotisserie chicken (2-2 1/2 lbs) cut up into pieces (Skin removed, if you like)
- 1/4 cup fresh cilantro leaves, chopped
- Cooked rice (optional
- **Directions:**
- Lime wedges Salad, Avocado (optional)
- 1. In a non stick 12" skillet, heat oil over medium heat until hot. Add onion and cook stirring occasionally, 5 minutes. Add garlic, chili powder, cocoa and cinnamon to skillet: cook stirring constantly, 1 minute.
- Stir in broth, peanut butter and tomato paste. Add raisins: heat 2. to boiling. Add chicken pieces to skillet. Reduce heat to medium-low; cover and simmer, turning chicken pieces half way through cooking to coat all sides with sauce, about 5 minutes. (10 minutes if the chicken has been refrigerated)
- 3. Sprinkle chicken with cilantro. Serve chicken and sauce over rice with a salad if you like. Garnish with lime wedges.




